This staff is responsible to support Pastors in the Worship & Music (W&M) Ministry. The focus is to uplift the W&M Ministry in SKMC and to coordinate all aspects of W&M.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work closely with the W&M Committee on all matters relating to worship and music, including planning, budgeting, organizing, and implementing.
- Assist the pastoral team to manage W&M and AV for all major church events.
- Assist church members in understanding the meaning, purpose, and practice of worship.
- Encourage and support the recognition of musicians, singers and AV crew, and discover and develop persons to serve in the ministry of worship. This responsibility also includes teaching persons of all ages our heritage of song and the use of music in worship.
- Plan for the ministry and training of worship leaders, song leaders, Scripture readers, and musicians.
- Assist with production upkeep, maintenance and acquisition support for W&M.
- Assist and work with the various committees for all major church services in the year
- Coordinate and support activities planned by SKMC's W&M Committee, CAC Board of Worship & Music, Methodist School of Music and other Worship and Music events related to the Methodist Church in Singapore.
- Promote the use of Methodist worship material.
- Any other duties as assigned by the Pastor-in-charge

REQUIREMENTS

- A mature and responsible Christian, hardworking and able to work in a team
- At least 5 years of experience serving in the Worship & Music ministry, particularly in worship leading and coordinating and working with volunteer musicians
- A clear passion and gift for music and worship
- A degree in Music & Christian Worship from an accredited institution [or a recognizable institution, at our discretion] with the Methodist Church in Singapore, as well as formal training and qualification in one or more of these areas:
 - music performance
 - sound production
 - music theory
 - music education

is preferred. Absent such qualifications, a demonstration of equivalent knowledge, skill, and willingness to pursue further study and training is required.

- Good organisational and communication skills, able to represent the church leadership at congregational and churchwide level to uplift the W&M Ministry in SKMC.
- Able to coordinate and support worship teams from all worship services, in English and in Mandarin, to understand the meaning, purpose, and practice of worship.
- Willing to take on secondary role(s) as assigned by the Pastor-in-charge.
